Youth groups

We run monthly groups for different age ranges. You can chat, make new friends, play games and chill with other young people who may be in a similar situation to you.



Events

Activities and trips that give you a well earned break from caring and a chance to try new fun things.



1:1s

1:1 support gives young carers a chance to talk and set goals. We can work through any issues or problems that may be worrying you.

Young carers assessments

We can visit you at home or at school to carry out a young carer assessment. This helps us to find out a little more about you and your caring role.

Discounts for carers

Our Carers Discount Card gives you discounts at a range of shops and services in York.



Carers Emergency Card

A card you can carry so you don't have to worry about what will happen to the person you look after if you have an emergency.



Young Carers Revolution

You can join this group of Young Carers that regularly meet up to speak out about issues that affect them. These young people let those in power know what needs to be changed to make a real difference.



Schools work

We work with schools to help staff and pupils understand what it is like to be a young carer and how they can support you. In some schools we run a drop-in, exclusively for young carers. We can also help your school gain national recognition through the Young Carers in School Award.

Your school can be awarded for good practice, giving young carers equal access to education and future life chances.



18 to 25 year olds
